The addiction advice center **FAM** is a place for women, trans*, inter* and non-binary people in the district Tempelhof-Schöneberg. We work with people of all ages and in all phases of substance use: accepting, exit-oriented, abstinence stabilizing.

We understand addictive substances use and addicting behaviors as individual strategies, which people develop, to cope with special burdens and difficulties. These are co-founded in the social structures, but can also be seen in the biography of each individual.

In addition to advice for those affected, FAM also offers **information, exchange** and **advice** for relatives and caregivers of people using addictive drugs and also for professional helpers from independent organizations or institutions. We can offer advice in English, Russian and German.

Advice is free of charge and, if requested, anonymous.
